1. PUBLIC FORUM

Whetley to Eggardon Road had a huge pot hole which has been filled today.
Pot hole just up from Marquis, really deep
Fibre broadband has now arrived in Poorton
Up to Leigh Gate from Rose Cottage – road needs resurfacing
Outside Mangerton Beck – large pot holes
Crain at Larcombe Lane needs cleaning out with jetter
As you approach Powerstock there is a stone wall that would look better if the brambles were cleared and earth mound cleared. Could some councillors look at doing it?
Road to Burcombe is in a bad state
Side verging has been done (Springhill Farm) but they dump it in the waterways
Bottom of Langden – a bad repair which enables vehicles to drive on a patch they shouldn't – dumped tar on top of a soft surface.
