## 1. PUBLIC FORUM

Road from Wytherston to Mount Pleasant - water pouring out over road.  
Spickhatch to Melplash trning - both sides of road hedgerow needs trimming back - Cllr Marsh to speak to owners.  
Pot hole at Marsh Dairy - extremely large.  
Mud blocking drains outside building site but they have made efforts to clear this up. Deliveries have been coming at school times - Cllr LEster-Card to speak to them to suggest coming outside of these times.  
Eggardon road pot holes - Cllr Frampton has spoken to Highways.  
Springhill Farm drain - same again- waters goes all over the road. member of public has reported to Highways.  
Crossroad at Yellow Lane - large pot hole. Tell Lodars Parish Council.  
Steps broken/eroded at green where bus shelter is in West Milton. Highways have been informed. Cllr Jackman to sheck with Post Office and see if they need to deal as the steps go up to their post box.  
Same pot holes across parish that are all still awaiting repair

D Hawkins advised all that the path near Jim Bull's farm has been washed away. it is actually an unclassified road - highways should repair but has no money. Could the Parish Council help? This is not something that has been budgeted for in the precept so it would depend on how much the parish council are being asked for as only have a very small amount of funds.
